### PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was held by the Spalding County Board of Commissioners in their office in the Courthouse Annex, Monday, February 5, 2001 beginning at 5:45 o'clock p.m. with Commissioners, Michael Kendall, Martha McDaniel, Merrill Massengale, Johnie McDaniel and Dick Morrow present. Also present were County Manager William Wilson and County Clerk Phyllis Doane.

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Johnie McDaniel. Chairman Massengale was present but could not preside because of laryngitis.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive public comment regarding the Fiscal Year 2001 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG).

Major Greg Potter was present to discuss this grant. He explained that the grant is in the amount of \$48,742 and requires a 10% match from Spalding County of \$4,874, which totals \$53,616. This money would be used to complete the mobile data network system that was purchased about two years ago for the road deputies as they have laptop computers in their vehicles.

There was no one else present who wished to make comment.

*Upon motion by Commissioner Martha McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner Morrow, the meeting was unanimously adjourned.*
