

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

The Spalding County Board of Commissioners held a Special Called Meeting at the Legislative Building, 18 Capitol Square, Suite 407, Atlanta, GA on Monday, September 24, 2001 at 11:30 a.m. at the Reapportionment Office.

Those present were Commissioners Michael Kendall, Dick Morrow, Martha McDaniel, Johnie McDaniel, Merrill Massengale, County Manager William Wilson, Assistant County Manager Michael Sabine and County Clerk Phyllis Doane. Also present were Chairperson of Board of Elections Helen Grayson, Kimberly Slaughter, Clerk with Voter Registrar's Office and Chris Cecil with *Griffin Daily News*. Angela Kennedy and Linda Meggers with the Reapportionment Office were present to draw the maps.

The Commissioners were reminded in drawing these maps to keep in mind the following: (1) keep precincts in tact as much as possible; (2) keep population of 11,683 as much as possible; (3) respect minority rights (4) keep deviation 5 per cent or under and (5) reference Shaw vs. Reno challenge.

After three hours of deliberation, discussion and drawing, three (3) proposed maps were drawn. They will be reviewed by staff and Board of Commissioners for corrections and then presented to the public in way of public hearings and a map will then be endorsed by the Board and then will be sent to the Justice Department for approval.

Upon motion by Commissioner Johnie McDaniel, seconded by Commissioner Martha McDaniel the meeting was unanimously adjourned at 2:05 p.m.
