PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was held by the Spalding County Board of Commissioners in their office in the Courthouse Annex, Thursday, June 27, 2002 beginning at 6:00 o'clock p.m. with Commissioners, Michael Kendall, Merrill Massengale, and Dick Morrow present. Commissioners Martha McDaniel and Johnie McDaniel were absent. Also present were County Manager William Wilson, Assistant County Manager Michael Sabine, and County Clerk Phyllis Doane.

A. **Call to order:** Vice Chairman Dick Morrow called the meeting to order. He presided over the meeting in the absence of Chairman Johnie McDaniel.

B. Special Exceptions:

1. **Application #02-16S:** Cornell and Beverly Smith, Owners – 214 Horseshoe Bend Circle (2.117 acres located in Land Lot 49 of the 2nd Land District) – requesting a Special Exception to allow a Class A Manufactured Home in the AR-1 District.

There was no one signed up to speak for or against this application. The applicants were present but did not request to speak. The application stated they were replacing mobile home with a 1944 sq. ft manufactured home and possibly be even more square footage.

Upon motion by Commissioner Kendall, seconded by Commissioner Massengale Application #02-16S was unanimously approved by a vote of 3-0.

1. Consider appointment of committee consisting of County Manager, Assistant County Manager, County Attorney and Finance Director to renegotiate LOST distribution with the City of Griffin.
