## Board of Commissioners

### SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Spalding County, Georgia, held a Special Called meeting on Monday, December 30, 2002 in their office in the Courthouse Annex in the City of Griffin, Spalding County, Georgia, beginning at 4:30 o'clock p.m. with Commissioners Martha McDaniel, Merrill Massengale, Dick Morrow, Johnnie McDaniel, Michael Kendall, Commissioners Elect Cecil Davis and Eddie Goss present. Also present were County Manager William Wilson, Assistant County Manager Michael Sabine, County Attorney Jim Fortune, Finance Director Jinna Garrison and County Clerk Phyllis Doane. Special guests also present were David Luckie, Executive Director of Griffin-Spalding County Development Authority, Rachel Spears, King and Spalding and Todd Barnes, A. G. Edwards & Co.

Chairman Johnnie McDaniel called the meeting to order.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider projects for inclusion on a March 18, 2003 SPLOST referendum.

The Board was in consensus with the land acquisition for industry; however, there was a discussion regarding the University Technology Center \$2.375M proposed SPLOST project and Mr. Luckie was asked to have representatives from the University of Georgia to present the project concept at a special called meeting Monday, January 6, 2003 at 5:00 P.M.

Rachel Spears, King and Spalding commented that the \$375,000 for operational expense included in the Technology Center cost estimate could not be paid out of SPLOST funds.

After a lengthy discussion regarding possible projects, the consensus of proposed projects are as follows:

\$30.7 Million Bonded to include Development Authority request and \$375,000 for parkland acquisition to purchase land adjacent to Fairmont Park.

\$800,000 for City of Griffin Transportation Projects.

\$800,000 for Spalding County Resurfacing Projects.

\$250,000 for City of Sunny Side Projects.

\$250,000 for City of Orchard Hill Projects.

\$500,000 for Senior Center expansion (total project \$1M with half financed by CDBG Grant match)

\$1,000,000 for Park Land Acquisition.

*There being no further business or discussion, Chairman McDaniel adjourned the meeting at 6:55 P.M.*
