DIRECTIONS TO SPALDING COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION CITY PARK COMMUNITY CENTER, GRIFFIN, GEORGIA

From Highway 16 West

Travel East on Highway 16 to Griffin. Travel through town and turn right onto 8th Street. Travel a few blocks and see Spalding Regional Hospital on your right (be prepared to turn right before you pass the hospital). Turn right onto Graefe Street which runs along the emergency entrance to the hospital.

Follow until you see an entrance to City Park. Turn left into the park. As you enter the park look to your left and see a gray building (gym). Look for left turn to get to the facility.

From I-75

Exit # 205 Griffin Jackson. Travel west on Hwy 16 for approx. 11 miles. Turn left onto 8th street. Travel a few blocks and see the Hospital emergency entrance. Turn right onto Graefe St. and follow until you see the entrance to the park. Look to the left and see a gray building and make a left turn to get to the facility.
