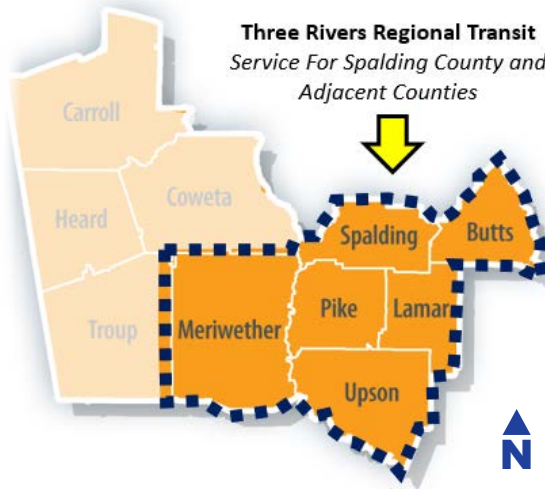


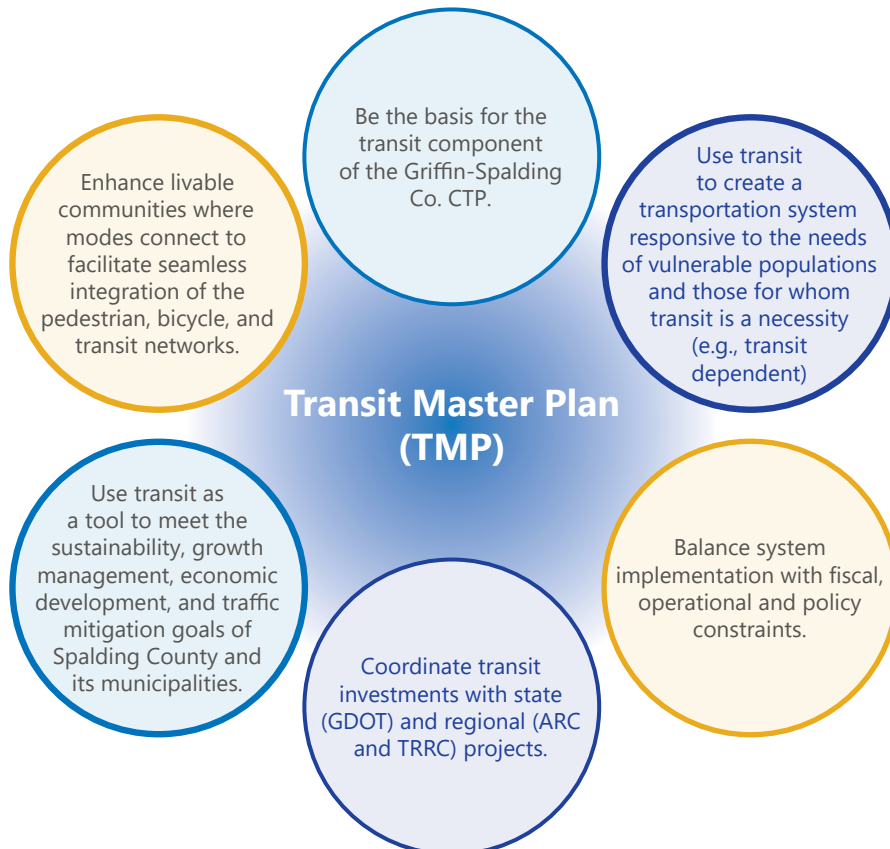
Spalding County, through its Board of Commissioners, have requested the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) help fund a specific plan for transit implementation study.
