## Board of Commissioners of Spalding County Regular Meeting Monday, August 2, 2021 6:00 PM Room 108, Annex Building

**The Spalding County Board of Commissioners were scheduled to hold their Regular Meeting in Room 108 of the Spalding County Annex on Monday, August 2, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. with Vice Chairman Dutton and Commissioner Rita Johnson being present for the meeting. Also present were Interim County Manager, Michelle Irizarry, County Attorney, Stephanie Windham and County Clerk, Kathy Gibson to record the minutes.**
