

### **NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

The Spalding County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in General Fund property taxes by 32.49% over the rollback millage rate.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Spalding County Courthouse Annex, Meeting Room 108, located at 119 East Solomon Street, Griffin, GA on September 5, 2023, at 6:30 p.m., September 18, 2023, at 9:00 a.m., and September 18, 2023, at 6:30 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 18.826 mills, an increase of 4.617 mills above the rollback rate. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 14.209 mills.

The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$100,000 is approximately \$184.68 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$75,000 is approximately \$138.51.
