B. AGENDA ITEMS

1. Consider establishing fees related to the Right of Travel Permit established in Section 6-2007 of the Spalding County Code of Ordinances adopted by the Board of Commissioners at their meeting on August 21, 2023.
2. Consider establishing approved truck routes within Spalding County and a fee schedule for truck route exemption permits.
3. T.J. Imberger, Director of Parks, Public Grounds and Public Works to update the Board on the results of the final interviews with United Pools and Aquatic Management prior to consideration of a contract.
4. Consider request from the Spalding County Public Works Department to review and consider support of GDOT installation of Reduced Conflict U-Turns (RCUT) at the following intersections on 19/41:
 - Crestwood Drive, no new U-turn median breaks proposed.
 - Laprade Road, no new U-turn median breaks proposed.
 - Glenwood Drive, one new U-turn median break proposed ~0.25 miles to the north.
 - Manley Road, one new U-turn median break proposed ~0.15 miles to the south.
 - Minter Road, one new U- turn median break proposed
 - ~0.15 miles to the south SR 3/US 41 @ Moreland Road

This request will also include support for signal upgrades at the following intersections on 19/41:

- Vineyard
 - Birdie Road
 - School Road
 - Malier Road
