

2024 QUALIFYING FEES

The governing authority of each County shall fix and publish the qualifying fees for the upcoming General Primary and General Election. O.C.G.A., Section 21-2-131(a)(1), provides as follows:

“The governing authority, not later than February 1, 2020 shall fix and publish qualifying fees for each County office to be filled in the upcoming General Election. Such fee shall be 3% of the annual salary if a salaried office. If not a salaried office, a reasonable fee shall be set by the governing authority not to exceed 3% of the income derived from such office by the person holding the office for the preceding year.”
